
Parents

Parking at Somerton Park







 Use the parking lot adjacent to the field






Parking at Roland Michener




- You have two choices for parking

- There are 3 fields at Roland Michener School. Our field is shown in white




Roland Michener – Tuesday

Parking at Insmill Park




- The parking lot is small at Insmill Park (approximately 20 cars)

- Please do not park on Terry Fox Drive




Insmill Park – Monday






Insmill Park – Tuesday






Insmill Park - Wednesday

Parking at Klondike Park




- There is a small parking lot at the school on Halton Terrace
- Once that is full you will have to park on the street






Klondike Park – Tuesday
