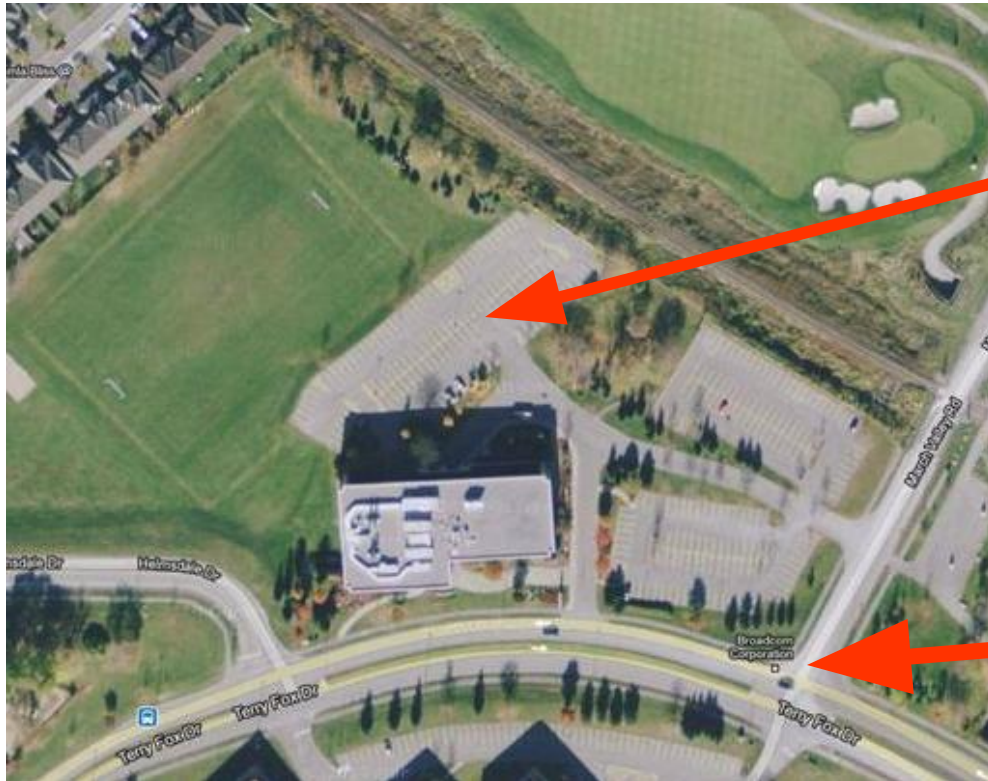
# Parents

# Parking at Somerton Park



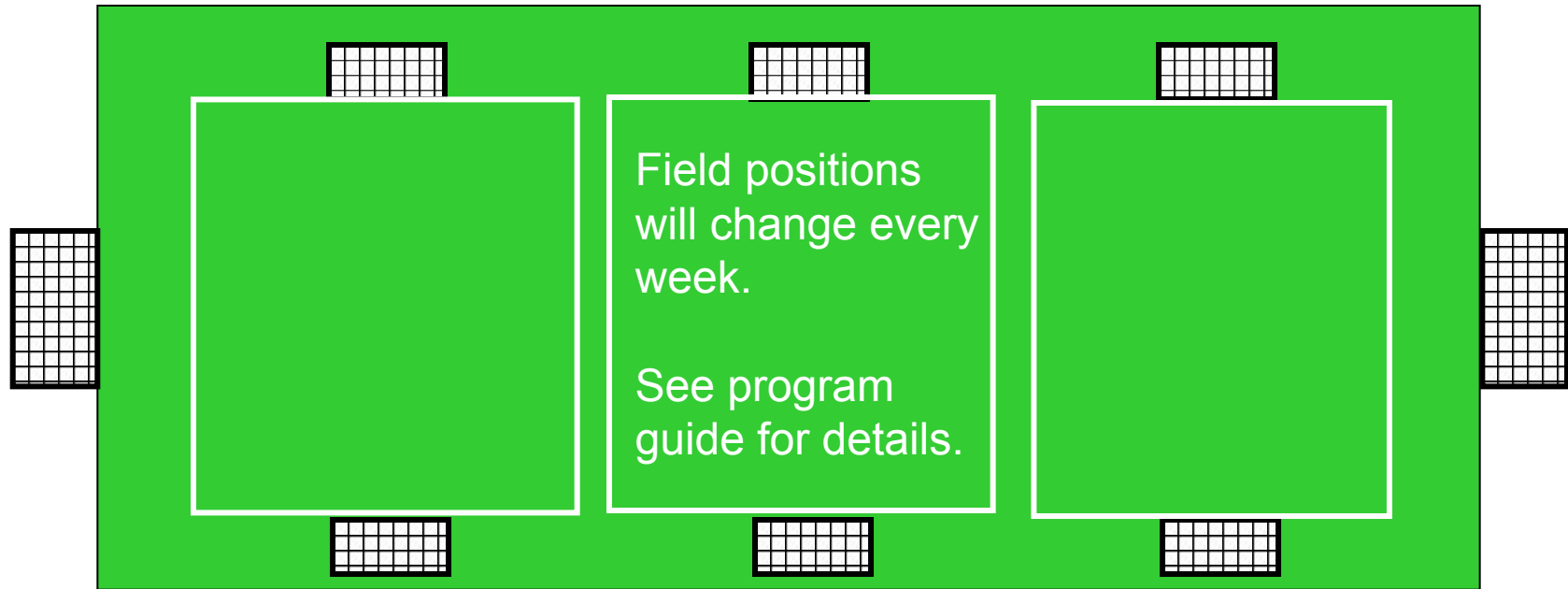
- Use the parking lot adjacent to the field

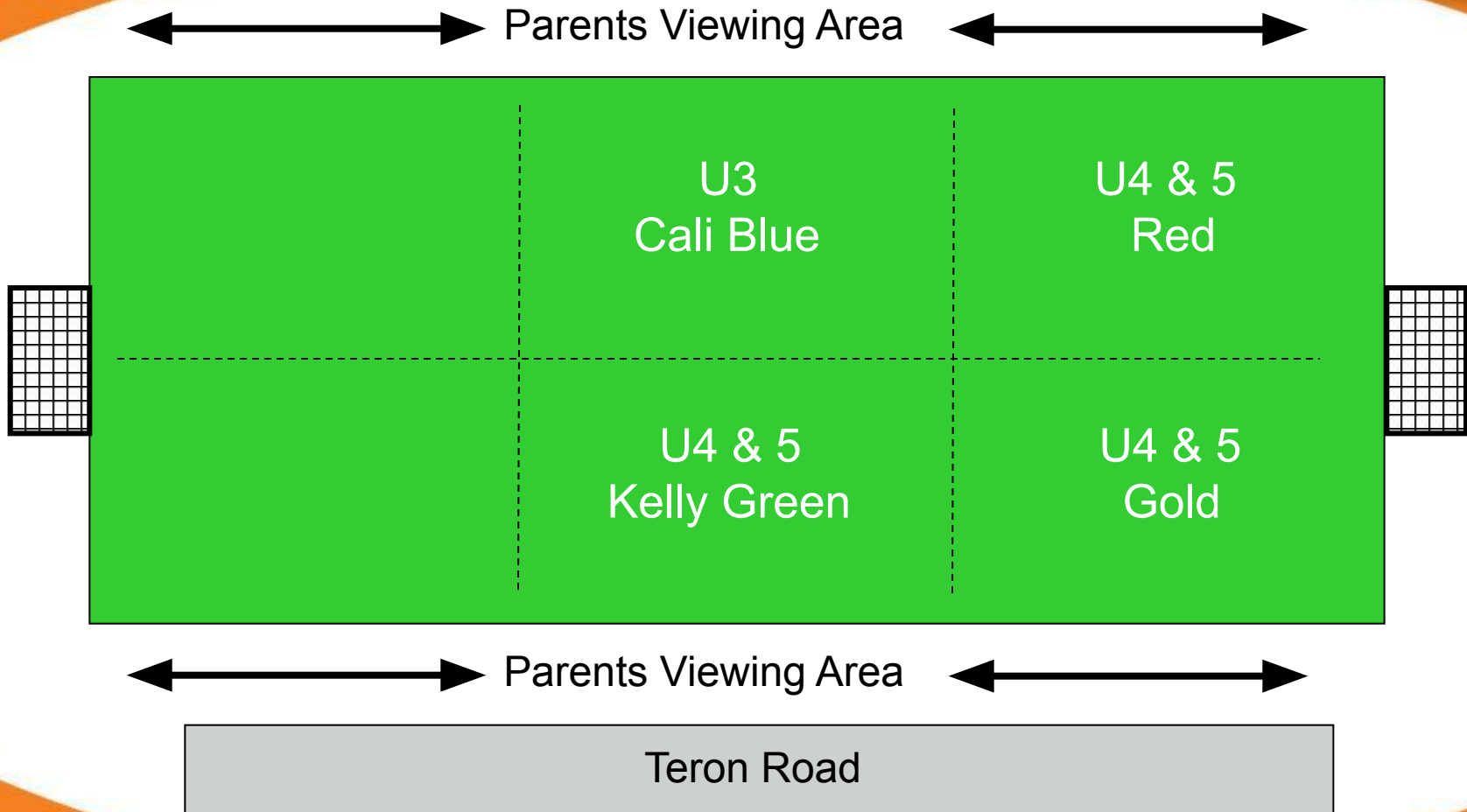
# Parking at Roland Michener



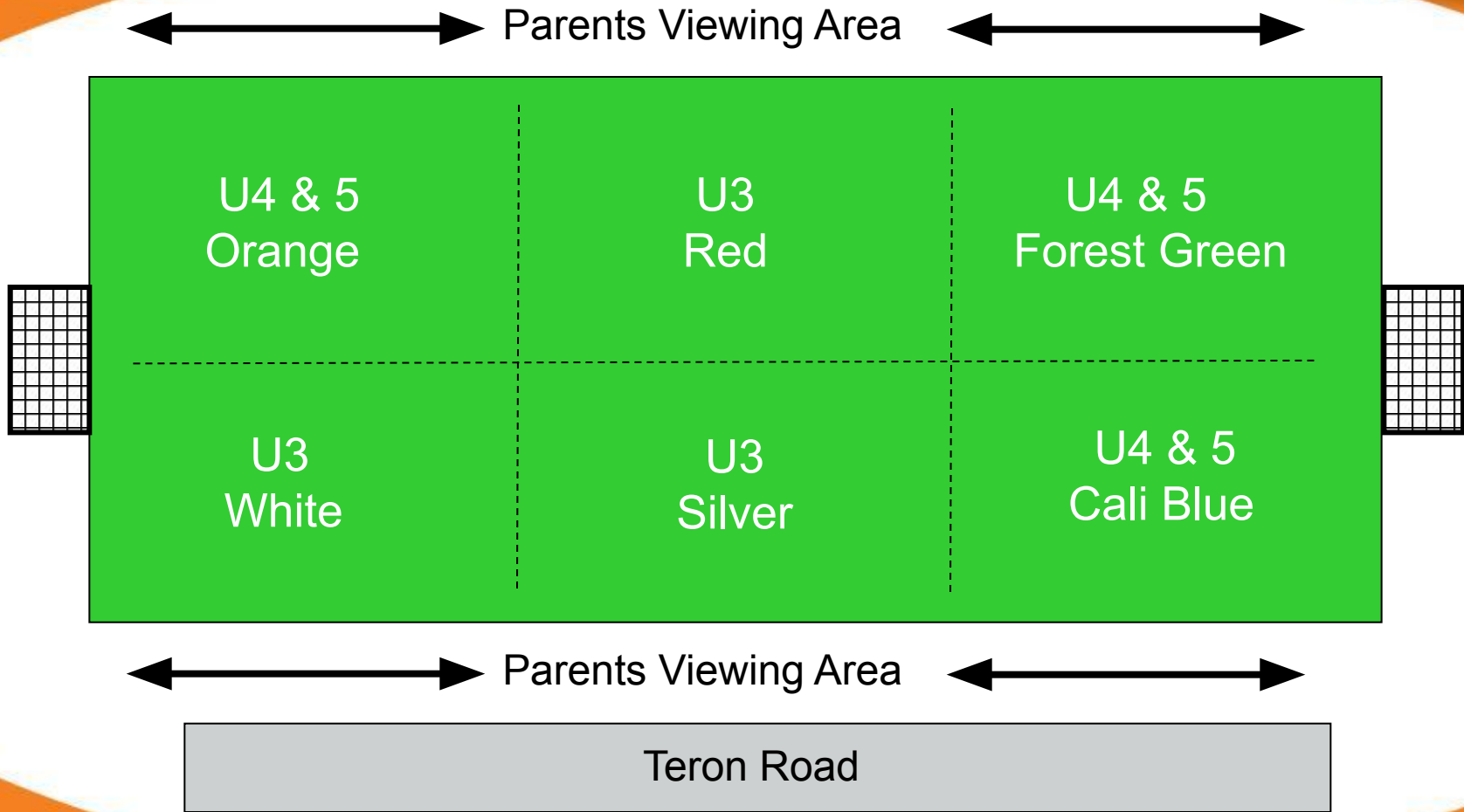
- You have two choices for parking

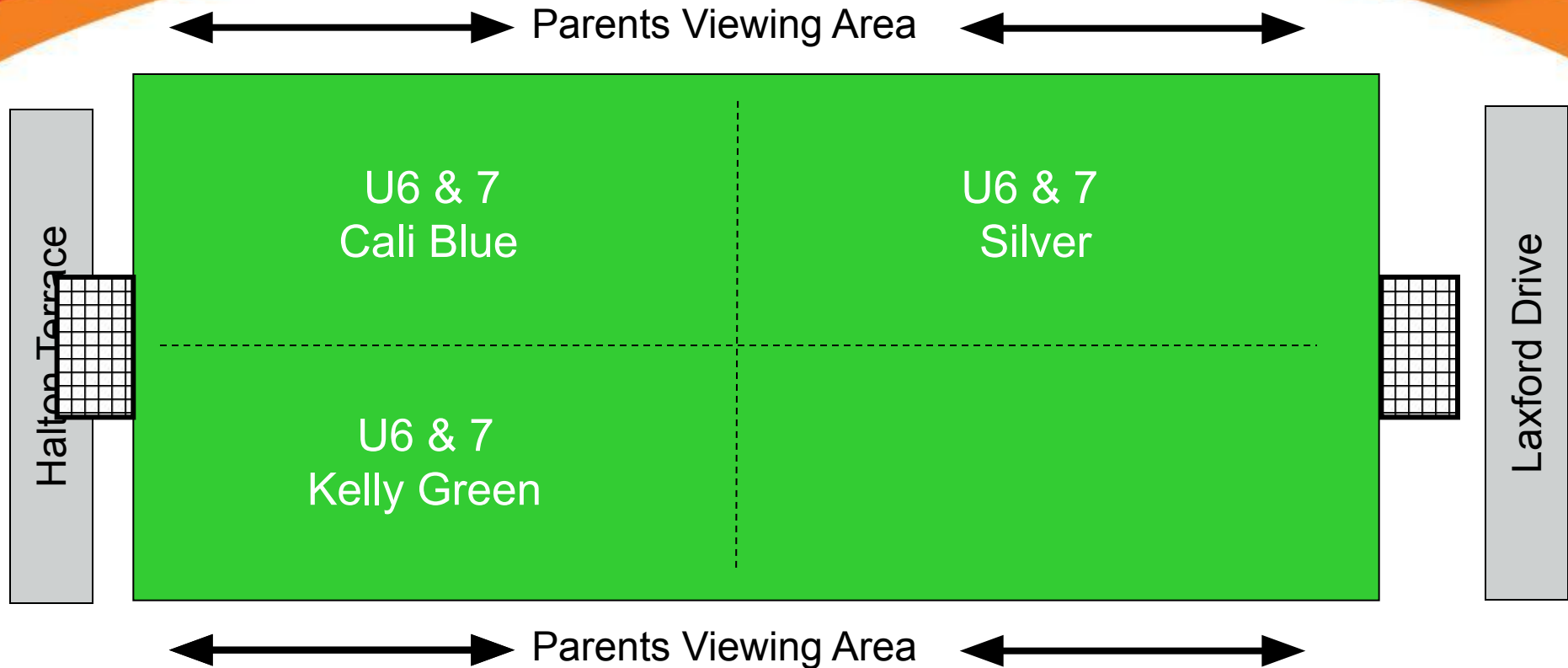
# Parking at Klondike Park



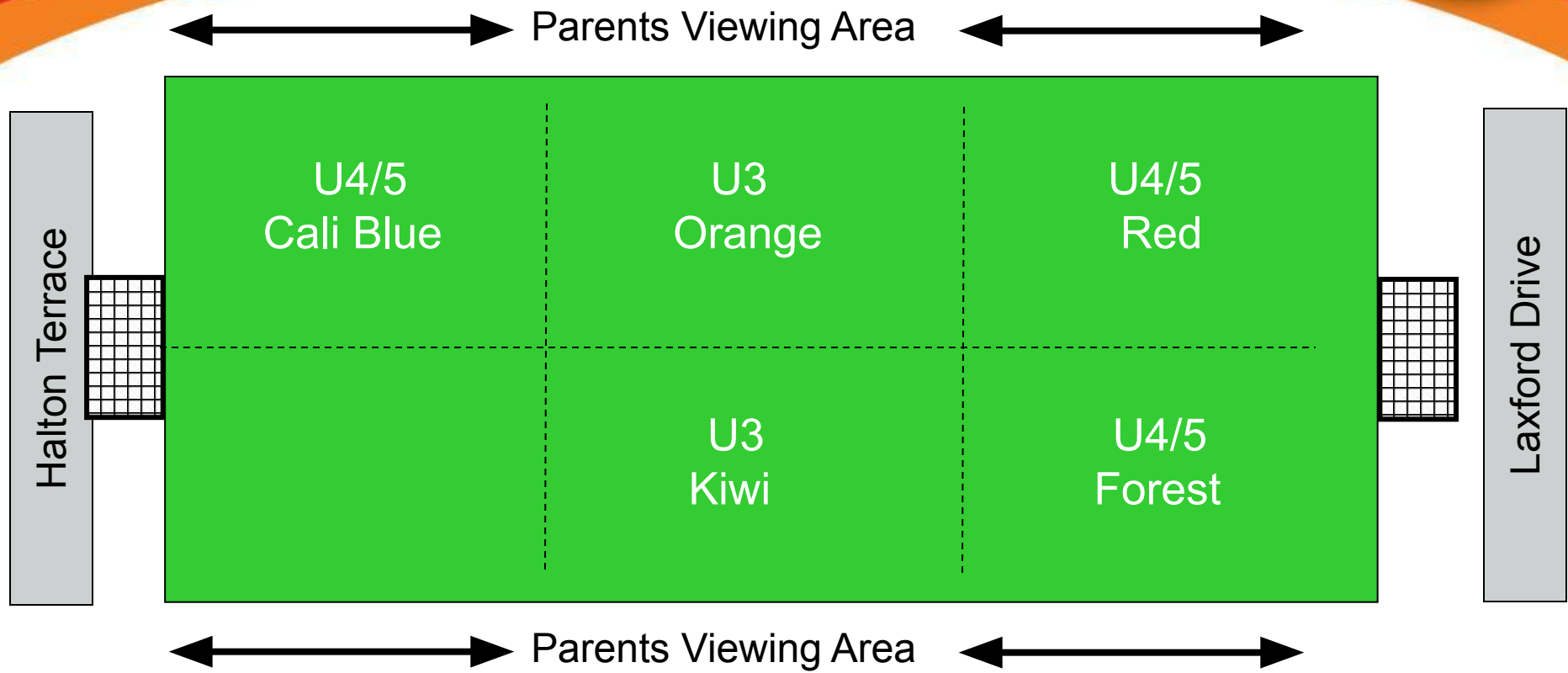
- There is a small parking lot at the school on Halton Terrace

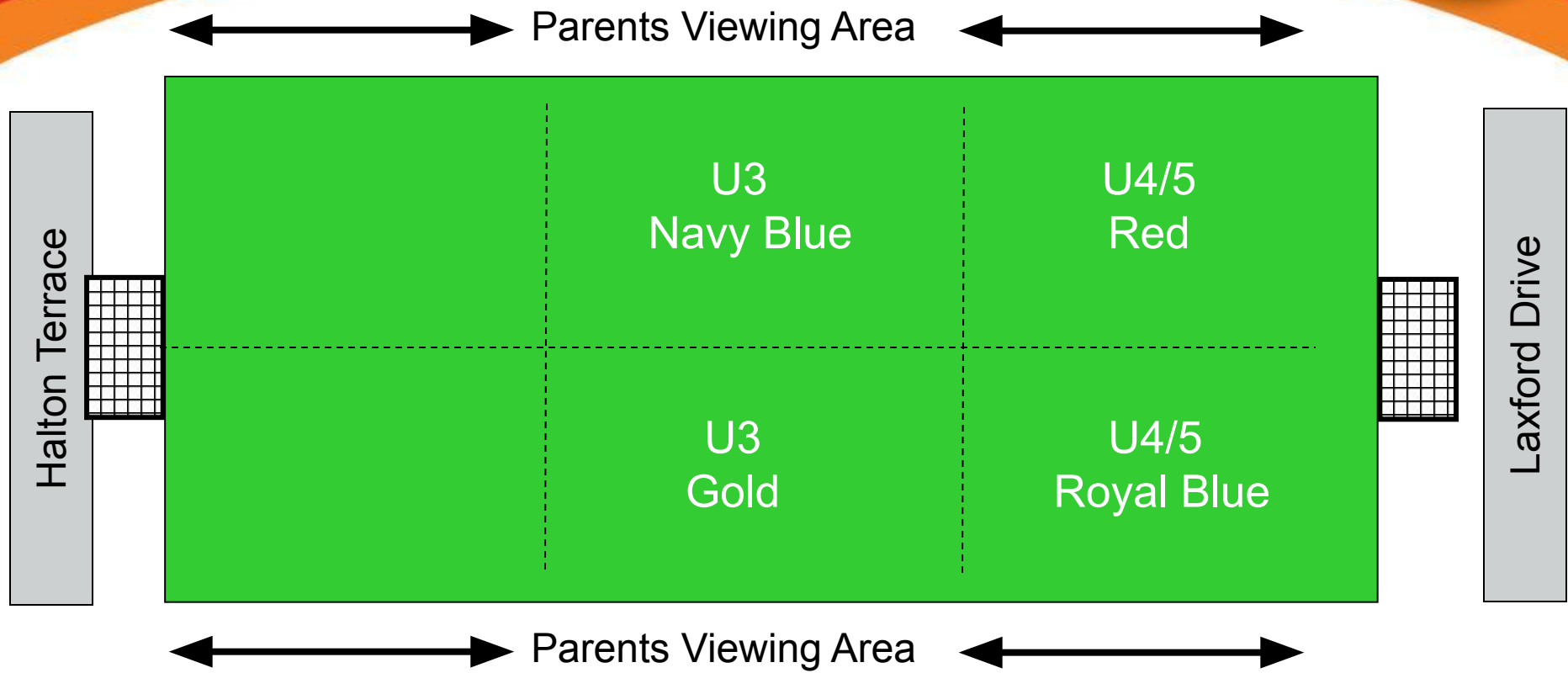
